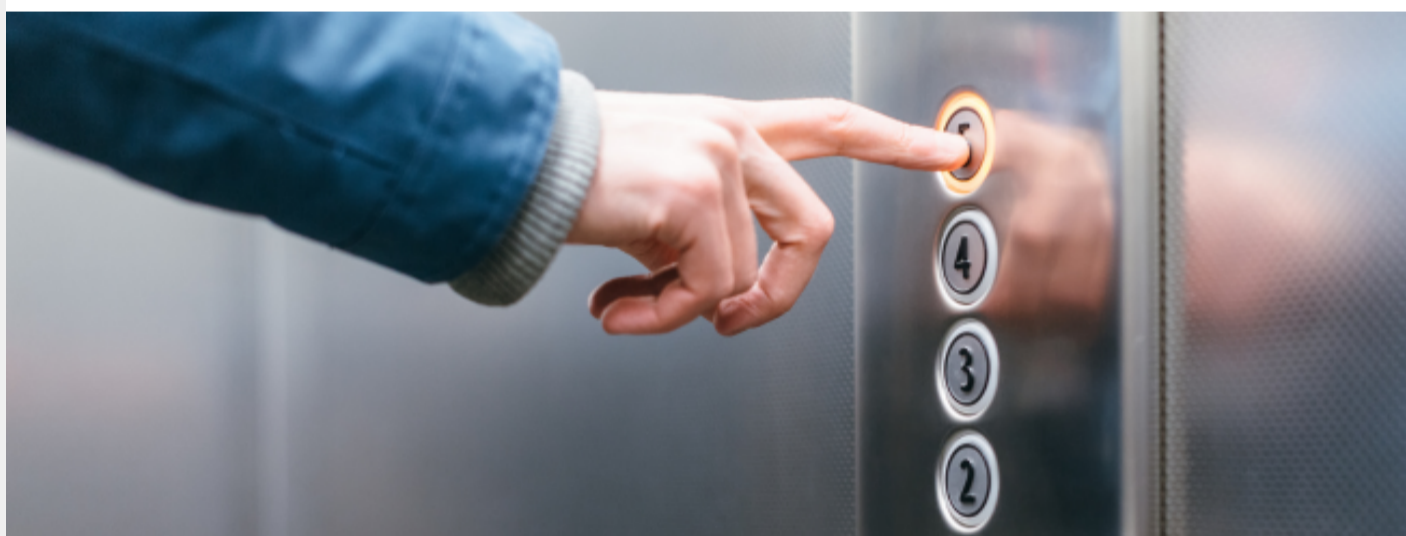


## March Is Brain Injury Awareness Month
